ACADEMIC GOAL:

- All students will learn reading foundational skills to develop a strong reading foundation.
- All students will learn to utilize graphic organizers in the form of Thinking Maps to help develop and organize ideas.
- All students will develop the conceptual knowledge of mathematics to become mathematical thinkers.

ENGLISH LEARNER GOAL:

- All students will speak in complete sentences.
- Utilization of sentence frames for speaking
- Provide visuals for students to reinforce vocabulary.

NON-ACADEMIC GOAL:

- Provide Social Emotional Learning: Second Step

At Home

ACADEMIC GOAL:

- Read and practice sight words daily.
- Read daily (15 minutes recommended)
- Encourage students to use problem solving skills- let them figure it out.
- Encourage mathematical thinking.
- Utilize online resources for learning.

ENGLISH LEARNER GOAL:

- Practice always speaking in complete sentences.
- Read daily or be read to daily.
- Utilize online resources for learning.

NON-ACADEMIC GOAL:

- Ensure your child is at school daily and on time.
- Encourage healthy sleep schedule and nutrition.
- Check agenda/homework folder daily.
- Check homework for accuracy.
- Speak to your child about the importance of school.
