The PE Department is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.

RULES:

- 1. Before entering the locker room, students are to line up quietly in a single file line in the designated area.
- 2. Cell phones <u>MUST NOT BE OUT AT ANY TIME DURING THE SCHOOL DAY</u>, especially in the PE area and locker room. Doing so will result in disciplinary action..
- 3. Destruction of school property or another student's property will result in a disciplinary referral.
- 4. <u>Inappropriate behavior</u> such as not keeping hands to yourself, physical aggression, screaming/yelling in the locker room, running/chasing, stealing, teasing, taking photos/videos and throwing items in the locker room will result in a disciplinary referral.
- NO CHANGING ALLOWED IN THE BATHROOM STALL. This bathroom stall is only to be used for restroom purposes. Once dismissed from the locker room, you may use the blacktop restrooms with permission from your PE teacher.
- 6. NO FOOD OR DRINKS allowed in the locker room. Only water bottles/containers.
- 7. Use of foul or derogatory language will result in a disciplinary referral.

DRESSING/CHANGING:

- 1. Eight (8) minutes will be allotted for dressing/changing.
- 2. Lock all valuables in your assigned locker (including wallet/money, phone, laptop, and/or other electronics).
- 3. Place backpacks out of the walkway (inside a long locker or underneath bench).
- 4. Once dressed, have a seat quietly on the bench and wait to be dismissed.
- 5. After dismissal, all students are to report to their PE classes and sit/stand on their assigned PE attendance/roll call number. Any student out of PE area/tardy to class after dressing/changing without permission will be sent to the office on a disciplinary referral.

LOANERS:

- 1. The number of times a student can borrow clothes will depend on the following schedule:
 - a. August-October: Once a week
 - b. November-December: 3 times in this timeframe
 - c. January-February: 2 times in this timeframe
 - d. March-May: 1 time in this timeframe
- 2. If borrowing, students must get in line immediately in the first two (2) minutes of entering the locker room.
- 3. Loaners must be worn by the student who checked them out if this rule is violated, then BOTH students will lose borrowing privileges for the remainder of the school year.
- 4. Loaners must be returned at the end of the PE period.

LOCKERS:

- 1. Lockers will be assigned once a student has a lock in possession AND has the last page of the Girls' PE Locker Room Rules signed by both student and a parent/guardian.
- 2. Once a locker has been assigned, there will be no moving/changing locker locations unless recommended by school administration.
- 3. Lockers are only to be used during the PE period and not throughout the day.
- 4. **ABSOLUTELY** no food or drinks are to be kept in the locker at any time.
- 5. Locker combinations should be written in your agenda on the designated page in case you forget.
- 6. **NEVER** share your locker combination.
- 7. **NEVER** share lockers! If students are caught sharing, both/all students will lose locker privileges and will then need to carry their own PE clothes for the remainder of the year.

Locker Room Rules - Mrs. Marty

- 8. Weekly locker checks will be done to ensure all students are following the rules of the locker room. Disciplinary actions will be taken for rules that are not followed such as loss of locker room privileges and/or office referral.
- 9. **The PE Department is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.**

LOST AND FOUND:

If any items have been misplaced or left behind, students may check in the lost and found bin located in front of the PE office door. If items are not there, they must be replaced.

PURCHASING PE CLOTHES (THROUGHOUT THE YEAR):

Magnolia PE uniforms are available to be purchased year-round through the PE locker rooms at the following prices:

PE Shirt - \$12.00 PE Shorts - \$12.00 Lock - \$6.00

Any student can purchase their own PE items outside of Magnolia JHS as long as the following are met:

- Shirt is one solid color, no designs, preferable gray.
- Shorts can be any color, with a drawstring, worn at the hip and at least fingertip length, no pockets.
- Combination locks can also be purchased on their own. Keep in mind, if combination lock breaks or stops working correctly, it will need to be replaced.
- Individual PE items bought outside of Magnolia JHS will need to be approved by the student's PE teacher.
