1. SPSA numeric goals

Goal 1 - Boys Republic will provide all staff with professional development and support in order to address the unique needs of the learners at our school and increase the Graduation Rate by 5%.

Metric- Graduation rate

Baseline - 66% of seniors who have been at BRHS for 90 or more days

Expected outcome - 71% of seniors who have been at BRHS for 90 or more days

So Far this Year - 6

Metric - GED completion rate

Baseline - 7 students earning GEDs

Expected outcome - Maintain number of students earning GEDs

So Far this Year - 6

Goal 2 - All students at BRHS will be given an Individualized Learning Plan to increase credit recovery or earning a GED. Rate to increase by 5% this year.

Metric - Absenteeism to decrease

Baseline - 2018 School Year Absenteeism rate 2%

Expected outcome - Decrease absenteeism by 1%

Metric - Suspension Rate

Baseline - 2018/2019 Suspension Rate of 17.8

Expected outcome - Decrease suspension rate by 10%

Metric – HSD & GED completion rate

Baseline - 2018/2019 HSD graduation rate 13% & GED completion rate 16%

18/135 HSD & 9/55 GED

Expected outcome - Increase HSD & GED completion by 5%

So Far this Year – 6 HSD

So Far this Year – 6 GED

Goal 3 - Increase completion rates of student in CTE, ROP and vocational programs by 3%.

Metric - Students in CTE classes who complete a block of 10 credits

Baseline - 3% of students complete a series of 10 credits.

Expected outcome - 6% of students who remain in the program for 18 weeks will complete a block of 10 credits in CTE courses.

Mr. Hampton Explanation

Goal 4 - All students will increase their entry assessment in ELA & Math upon exiting the program by an average of 5%.

Metric - 35 Day Papers, counseling checkups & Administration checkups on students.

Baseline –

33% of students are earning credit at a rate which allows for credit recovery

50% of seniors who enter the program with less than 50 credits to graduate are earning a HSD.

Expected outcome - 75% of students will earn credit at a rate which allows for credit recovery, and 60% of seniors who enter the program with 50 credits or less to complete graduation requirements who remain in the program for six months will earn a HSD.

Credit Completion so far this year

Seniors with less than 50 credits or less graduating so far this year

Goal 5 - 75% of long-term students (students who are in the program for 90 days or more) will participate in the Matrix Drug Prevention Program and or will complete a health class with an illicit drug component. All students to be advised of the consequences of breaking school, classroom or BR rules upon entrance into the school and each class.

Metric - Health course or Matrix Drug Prevention Program

Baseline - Baseline year - new course offering.

Expected outcome - 75% of long-term students (students who remain in the program for 90 or more days) will complete the one of the courses.

Health Course completion so far this year

Goal 6 - Students will increase one grade level of growth as measured by the Student Reading Inventory (Read 180 program) even though the average stay is only 2 months.

Metric - Student Reading Inventory from Read 180 Program

Baseline - Average reading score is 5.0

Expected outcome - Students who remain the program for over 90 days will gain an average of 1.0 in reading grade level.
